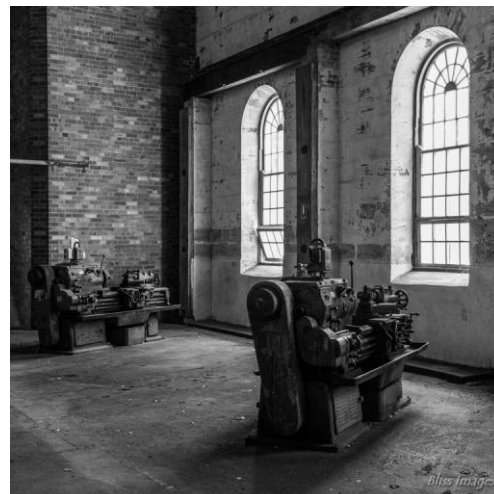


Cockatoo Island Black and White Shoot Sunday, 4th September

Cockatoo Island is a UNESCO world-heritage-listed island in the middle of Sydney Harbour. The island retains much of its character and heritage from decades of human endeavour by convicts and shipbuilders alike.

We will spend our day photographing the many old buildings remaining from convict and shipbuilding days. The buildings and old machinery, lend themselves to black and white photography.



The Plan for the day

- Arrive at Circular Quay in time to board the ferry
- **9:07** we will board the Ferry from wharf F3 at Circular Quay, arriving at Cockatoo Island at 9:28.
- **Sign the sign-on sheet while on the ferry**
- On arrival at the island, we will gather near the wharf and run through setting you camera to B&W and shooting in live view. You could pick up a coffee at this point if you want.
- Spend time wandering around the many old buildings
- **12:00** Lunch at Marina Cafe, at your own expense, located at Camber Wharf Marina on the Southern Apron. The cafe serves wraps, salads, dumplings, cakes and a range of snacks, along with coffee, tea and cold drinks including beer and wine.
- After lunch we will continue to photograph more of the island.
- **2:35 or 3:35**, depending on how we are going, we'll catch the ferry back to Circular Quay.

NOTE: If you plan to leave early, please let Peter know and make sure you are signed off. We don't want to leave anyone on the island overnight.

The Challenge

This is pretty simple really, to produce some amazing black and white images, building on the inspiration from Len Metcalf.

1. Building/machinery (1 digital and 1 print)
2. Anything else that takes your eye (1 digital and 1 print)
 - Seagulls
 - City skyline
 - People
 - More buildings/machinery

What to bring

- Camera
- Tripod
- Water
